

Glazing Team Member

Reports to the Glazing Supervisor on all matters. The Glazing Team Member will be responsible for general labour and glazing duties of our products. Duties and responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

Education

- High School Diploma or equivalent.

Years of Experience

- Experience in a manufacturing environment or glass window wall industry is an asset.

Working Conditions

- Factory plant environment;
- Work may involve some exposure to unusual elements, such as extreme temperature, dirt, fumes, smoke, unpleasant odors, and loud noises;
- Work environment involves some exposure to hazards of physical risks that require knowledge of an adherence to basic safety procedures;
- Work environment requires wearing PPE: safety footwear, safety glasses and hearing protection;
- Promote health and safety in the plant;
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs.; and
- Flexible to work approved overtime as required.

Required Skills

- Repetitive motion with hands and arms;
- Standing, twisting head, neck and upper body for entire shift;
- Hand eye coordination;
- Regular attendance is critical;
- Ability to use hand tools and accurately use a tape measure as required;
- Positive working attitude;
- Strong attention to detail and organizational skills;
- Work in a team environment by demonstrating State's core values;
- Good communication skills with the ability to take direction; and
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment.

Job Specific Duties

- Fabricating metal frames for glass installation;
- Measuring and marking lines or patterns on glass before cutting;
- Applying to use a silicon gun in between the frame and glass;
- Assembles glass in frame with heel bead and clean;
- Ability to put a glass stop to cover silicon and install insulation;
- Machine operation when required;
- Must pay attention to details;
- Always follow safe working procedures;
- Represent State as required, in business with customers, suppliers, visitors and other team members; and
- Any other duties assigned by the Glazing Supervisor.
